Juition Waivers

Tuition waivers are scholarships applied to the cost of tuition and are available for new and returning students. Awards range from \$250-\$1,000 per academic year. Applications are accepted year-round, but priority deadline is March 1.

Apply for Scholarships! Foundation scholarships and tuition waiver scholarships are awarded each spring. Applications are available online November 1, and the deadline to apply for most scholarships is March 1.
Submit All Official Transcripts! To complete the application process, you must submit all official

high school and college transcripts. Submit transcripts for all colleges you have attended.

Submit ACT/SAT Scores! (if applicable) If you have taken the ACT or SAT, submit your scores to Admissions and Advising.
Enroll in Classes! After you have submitted all of your documentation, meet with an academic advisor to enroll in classes.
